1. **ANZAC DAY**

The dawn and civic services were both well attended and the parade also attracted large crowds. It was particularly pleasing to see the number of younger people attending these services and honouring those who fought for their country. A highlight of the day was the WW2 war plane that did several low level fly overs and aerobatic rolls during the service at the Kopuatama Cemetery.

2. **STRATFORD HEALTH CENTRE**

Its great to see that the construction of the new Stratford Health Centre has finally begun and the hard work of the Health Trust members is about to be rewarded. The facility will provide the community with a first class "one stop shop" for health services and serve us well into the future. The consolidation of services will have a range of benefits and will be a more attractive proposition when recruiting medical staff. It is hoped the Centre will be fully operational by the end of the year.

3. **HORIZONS, RUAPEHU AND WANGANUI**

Recent statements from the Ruapehu and Wanganui District Councils saying they are investigating their options to break away from the Horizons Regional Authority, has implications for this district. Both neighbouring Councils have expressed an interest in forming unitary authorities. Should they be successful, then a part of our eastern districts, currently within the Horizons region, would be affected. The area would become isolated from the bulk portion of the Horizons region. This would be a ludicrous situation and I am sure this will generate considerable debate about the potential outcomes.

The Stratford District Council and its eastern ratepayers need to be part of any discussions on this subject and I have conveyed this view to the Mayor of Ruapehu District. A press release regarding this subject will be made available this week.

4. **UNEMPLOYMENT UPDATE**

Latest figures released show that the Stratford District Youth unemployment figures have improved from last month. There are currently 55 young people under the age of 25 years receiving the Unemployment Benefit in Stratford. The total Unemployment Benefit number is 157 people, but each week we are experiencing a slight decline in numbers. These numbers are still well below national predictions.

The two youth programmes; Job OPS and Community MAX, have been a real boost and are achieving great things for those young people involved. Of the young people completing placements under these programmes, only one has returned to the Unemployment Benefit in our region. Lots of effort is going in by Work Brokers with this group to ensure no one cycles back onto the Unemployment Benefit.

5. **STRATFORD OKAHUKURA RAILWAY LINE**

The future of the line remains uncertain. Kiwi Rail is still considering the options available to it, but recent comments from the Minister of Transport regarding rail transport in New Zealand, strongly suggest that a government funded reprieve looks unlikely.

6. **STRATFORD'S OF THE WORLD REUNION**

The re-union held in March was an outstanding success. The visitors from around the world had a tremendous time in Stratford and were very complimentary about the hospitality of the people and the generosity of the host families. I would like to thank the organising committee for the work they did and congratulate all those involved in making this such a memorable occasion.
