 2. Any affected party does not have to sign the Written Approval form if they are not giving approval.

AFFECTED PERSON'S APPROVAL

Where an applicant seeks a Resource Consent to be processed on a non-notified basis in accordance with S94(2) of the Resource Management Act 1991, Council will only consider this where the requirements below have been satisfied in full.

1. Persons/Parties who may be Adversely Affected

Consents are to be supplied by the applicant from any person/party who may be adversely affected by the proposal and this may include but is not limited to:

- Owners and Occupiers (ie tenants) of land adjacent to the site of a proposal.
- The relevant Iwi Authorities.

2. Documentation to be Supplied

- A drawn plan of the proposal is to be supplied to Council which contains written description of the proposal and which has been signed by every affected person/party including where appropriate both partners. In the case of relocated buildings, photos are to be supplied and signed by affected persons/parties including, where appropriate, both partners.
- A fully completed Affected Persons Consent form (ie "*Written Approval of Person Adversely Affected by the Granting of a Resource Consent*") is to be supplied to Council from every affected person/party including, where appropriate, both partners.

Note:

1. Council reserves the right to determine who may be adversely affected.
2. Council may determine it unreasonable in certain circumstances to require an affected persons approval to be obtained.
3. Affected Persons Consents will not be accepted that have been made conditional.
