Representation Review 2021

We're reviewing how we represent our communities.

Every three years elections are held for councils, with the next election taking place in 2022. To make sure we have fair and effective representation at these elections, councils are required by the Local Electoral Act 2001 to review their representation arrangements at least once every six years.

Why are we holding a representation review now? In May 2021, Council voted to establish a Māori Ward. As part of this decision, we're required to carry out a Representation Review.

At yesterday's Ordinary meeting, elected members discussed the different options available for representation and decided on their initial proposal.

This initial proposal will be available for everyone in the Stratford district to make a submission on from next week.

Information on what we're proposing and on how you can make a submission to have your say will be shared in the Stratford Press on 18 August 2021 and made available at Council offices and online at stratford.govt.nz
