Lids letting us down

Contamination of kerbside recycling is a big issue for Stratford - we need to get rid of the lid!

Nearly a quarter of the District's recycling going into kerbside recycling wheelie bins either can't be recycled or isn't being cleaned properly and contaminating good recyclables around it.

One of the main reasons for this contamination is containers and bottles that still have their lids on.

Lids are a huge problem. Loose lids clog up Material Recovery Facility (MRF) machinery and the bottles and containers with tops left on are treated as contaminated and disposed of to landfill. Unfortunately the MRF staff don't have the time to remove every lid, so we need your help!

Please remember to remove your lids and put them in your rubbish bin or find an alternative use for them.

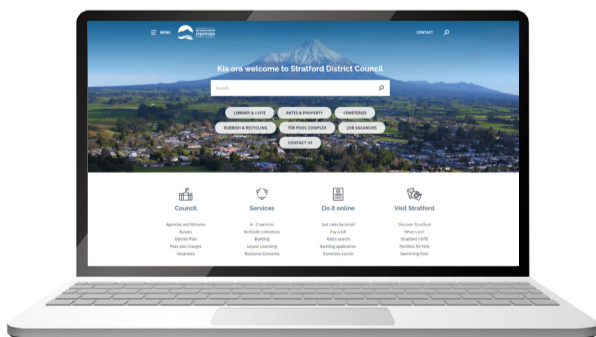
