## Are you being a responsible dog owner?

In the Stratford district we are lucky to be able to take our best fur-buddies almost anywhere, whether it's down to the river or for a walk to pick up the groceries.

To make sure everyone can enjoy our public spaces and there's a safe environment for dog and non-dog people, we ask dog owners to follow some guidelines:

- Make sure your dog is registered and wears a registration tag at all times.
- Clean up after your dog. Carry a disposable bag for picking up your dog's waste and put it in a rubbish bin.
- Don't let your dog wander or cause a nuisance by barking.
- Unless in a designated dog exercise area, you must have your dog on a leash in a public place.
- Don't take your dog to areas where dogs are not allowed.
