### Flush your taps

Some plumbing fittings have the potential to allow minute traces of metals to accumulate in water standing in the fittings for several hours.

Although the health risk is small, the Ministry of Health recommends that you flush a mugful of water from your drinking-water tap each morning before use to remove any metals that may have dissolved from the plumbing fittings.

We are recommending this simple precaution for all households, including those on public and private water supplies.

### Dog registration fees for a 12 month period from 1 July 2022 to 30 June 2023

Pursuant to Section 37 of the Dog Control Act 1996 the following will be the Dog Control fees for the 12 month period from 1 July 2022 to 30 June 2023.

Rural dog (for every dog up to and including first three dogs)	\$45.00	\$60.00

1. The criteria for these categories are given within the Stratford District Council Dog Control Policy.
2. Any application to be a Select Dog Owner must be made before 30 April of each registration year.
3. Infringements may be issued for all outstanding registrations after 1 October 2022.
4. Fees are subject to the adoption of the Annual Plan 2022/23 by Council.
