Residents invited to stay up to date with Antenno App

We are excited to announce that we are using Antenno, an easy to use free mobile app which helps residents stay up to date with council services and activity.

Antenno is free to download from the Google Play Store or App Store, and sends you notifications about places and topics that matter to you.

There are two ways you can use Antenno:

- to receive notifications from council about the places you have marked as important to you
- reporting back to council on issues or feedback.

Antenno lets you choose the places you want to be alerted about, so you're not being told about things that don't matter to you.

The app shows you updates from council for the 'places' you select as being important to you. This could be your work, home or rental property for example. You'll receive alerts about community events, matters that are up for consultation, water shutdowns and much more.



Get Antenno now to report community issues and receive Council alerts.



You can also use Antenno to tell us about things that need fixing, or give us feedback, direct through the app! Antenno makes it easy for people to submit feedback or report issues such as a full public rubbish bin, damaged footpath, road pothole or graffiti.

Did you know?

The secret to fixing a stinky compost pile can be as simple as one of these:

- Check to see if the pile is too soggy and add dry soil to correct this.
- Turn the pile at least weekly to add oxygen for the little organisms that are breaking down the waste.
- Increase the carbon (brown stuff - corrugated cardboard works well) if you smell ammonia, which could mean there is excess nitrogen.
- Make sure your pile or bin is located in full sun so it stays warm enough or cover with a black rubbish bag. The temperature of the pile needs to be between 40 and 60 degrees.
