1. Introduction

The Stratford District Council ('the Council') makes this Bylaw pursuant to:

- The Local Government Act 1974;
- The Local Government Act 2002 (Sections 145 & 146);
- The Land Transport Act 1998 (Section 22AB);
- The Land Transport (Road User Rule) 2004;
- The Land Transport Rule: Traffic Control Devices 2004;
- The Land Transport Rule: Setting of Speed Limits 2017; and
- The New Zealand Speed Management Guide 2016

2. Title

This bylaw is the Stratford District Council Speed Limits Bylaw.

3. Purpose

The purpose of this bylaw is to set safe speed limits on roads within the jurisdiction of the Stratford District Council ('the Council').

4. Commencement

This bylaw comes into force on 1 February 2020.

5. Review

This bylaw will be reviewed in 2030, in accordance with section 159 of the Local Government Act 2002.

6. Interpretation

(1) In this bylaw, unless the context otherwise requires, -

Bylaw means a bylaw of the Council for the time being in force, made under the provisions of any Act or authority enabling the Council to make bylaws.

Council means the Stratford District Council

District means the district of Stratford District Council

Road shall have the meaning assigned to it from time to time in the Local Government Act 2002, and shall where the context requires include a street.

Speed limit has the same meaning as in the Speed Limits Rule

Speed Limits Rule means the rule made under the Land Transport Act 1998 for the setting of speed limits that is in force at the time any speed limit is set by this bylaw. The Speed Limits Rule in force is the Land Transport Rule: Setting of Speed Limits 2017.

Street, Private Street, Footway and Private WAY shall have the respective meanings assigned to them in the Local Government Act 1974, and shall where the context requires include a road.

Urban traffic area means the same as in the speed Limits Rule and refers to the areas specified in the Schedules.

- (2) Any undefined words, phrases or expressions used in this bylaw have the same meaning as in the Land Transport Act 1998 and/or the Speed Limits Rule.

7. Speed Limits set by this bylaw

- (1) The roads or areas described in the Schedules or as shown on a map referenced in the Schedules are declared to have the speed limits specified in those Schedules and maps, which are part of this bylaw
- (2) The speed limits specified in Schedules 1 - 5 were determined in accordance with the Speed Limits Rule.
- (3) For the avoidance of doubt, unless a different speed limit is set and in effect under Schedules 2, 3 and 4, or an emergency speed limit or temporary speed limit is in force, the speed limit on roads within the within the Stratford district is:
 - a. 50km/h within the urban traffic areas specified in Schedule 1; and
 - b. 100km/h outside the urban traffic areas specified in Schedule 6.

8. Speed Limits set by Resolution

- (1) The Council may, by resolution, set speed limits and designate urban traffic areas for any roads under the Council's jurisdiction.
- (2) The Council may, by resolution, set speed limits for any roads under the Council's jurisdiction in any of the following designated locations:
 - a. Car park;
 - b. Educational facility;
 - c. Commercial or industrial facility;
 - d. Health facility;
 - e. Residential facility;
 - f. Marae grounds;
 - g. Camping ground;
 - h. Sports facility or other recreation area; and
 - i. Cemetery.
- (3) The Council may, by resolution, amend or revoke a resolution made under clauses 8 (1) or 8 (2) above.

9. Revocation and savings

- (1) On commencement of this bylaw, the Stratford District Council Speed Limits Bylaw 2008 is revoked.
- (2) All existing speed limits on Stratford district roads are revoked and replaced with the speed limits set by this bylaw.
- (3) In relation to any matter occurring before this bylaw was made, all speed limits on Stratford district roads that were in effect before this bylaw was made, continue to have effect for the purposes of:
 - a. Investigating an offence or breach;
 - b. Commencing or completing proceedings for the offence or breach; and/or
 - c. Imposing a penalty for the offence or breach.

10. Schedules

- (1) Schedule 1 - Urban traffic areas 50 km/h: The roads or areas described in this Schedule or as shown on a map referenced in this Schedule are declared to be urban traffic areas that have a speed limit of 50 km/h, except for those roads or areas that are:
 - a. Described as having a different speed limit in the appropriate Schedule of this bylaw; or
 - b. Shown on a map as having a different speed limit, as referenced in the appropriate Schedule of this bylaw.
- (2) Schedule 2 - 40 km/h Variable Speed Limit: The roads or areas described in this Schedule or as shown on a map referenced in this Schedule are declared to have a variable speed limit of 40 km/h.
- (3) Schedule 3 - 60 km/h: The roads or areas described in this Schedule or as shown on a map referenced in this Schedule are declared to have a speed limit of 60 km/h.
- (4) Schedule 4 - 70 km/h: The roads or areas described in this Schedule or as shown on a map referenced in this Schedule are declared to have a speed limit of 70 km/h.
- (5) Schedule 5 – 80km/h: The roads or areas described in this Schedule or as shown on a map referenced in this Schedule are declared to have a speed limit of 80 km/h.
- (6) Schedule 6 - Rural areas 100 km/h: The roads or areas described in this Schedule or as shown on a map referenced in this Schedule are declared to be rural areas that have a speed limit of 100 km/h.

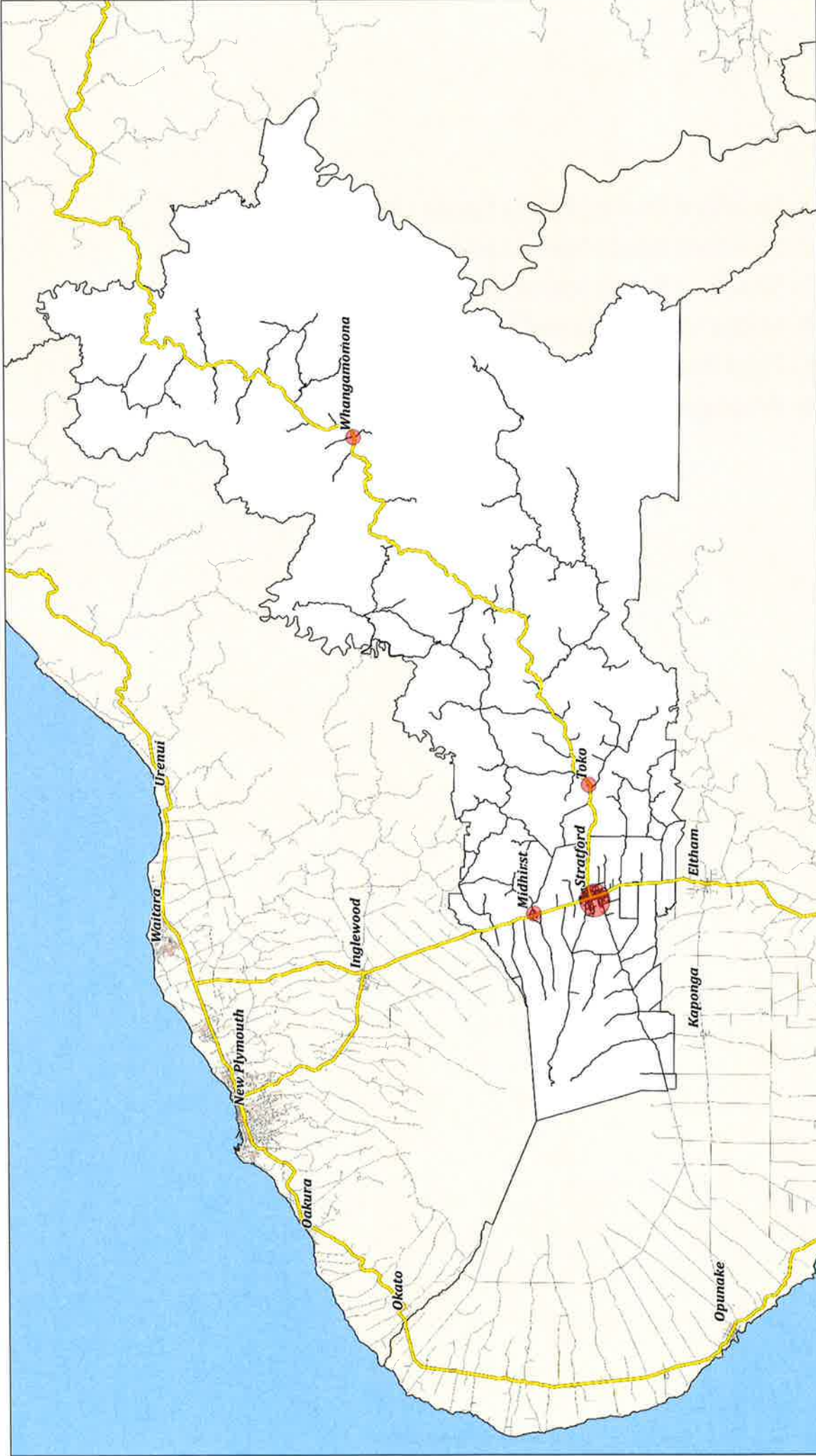

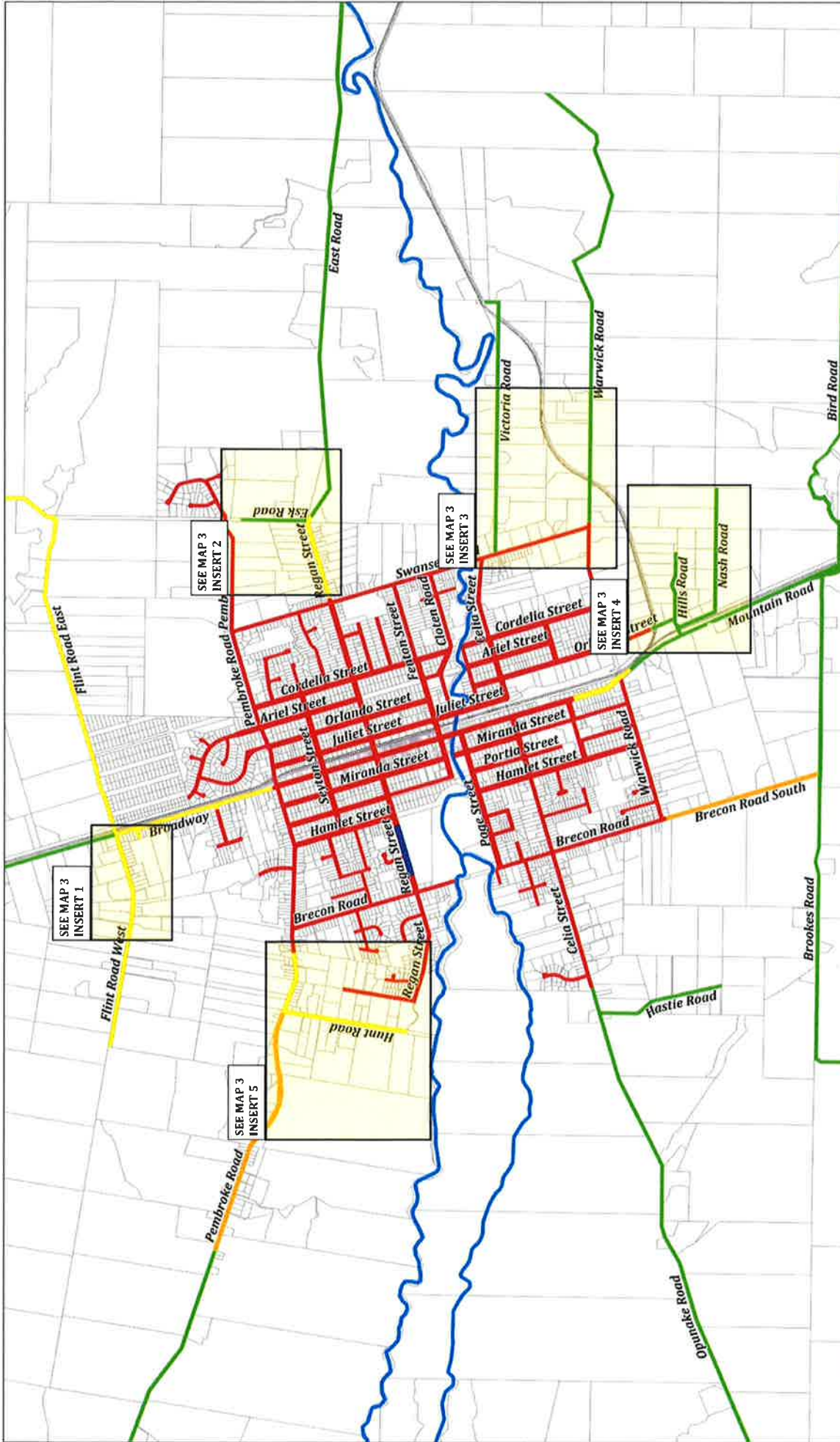

Map 2 - Stratford Roads Speed Limits

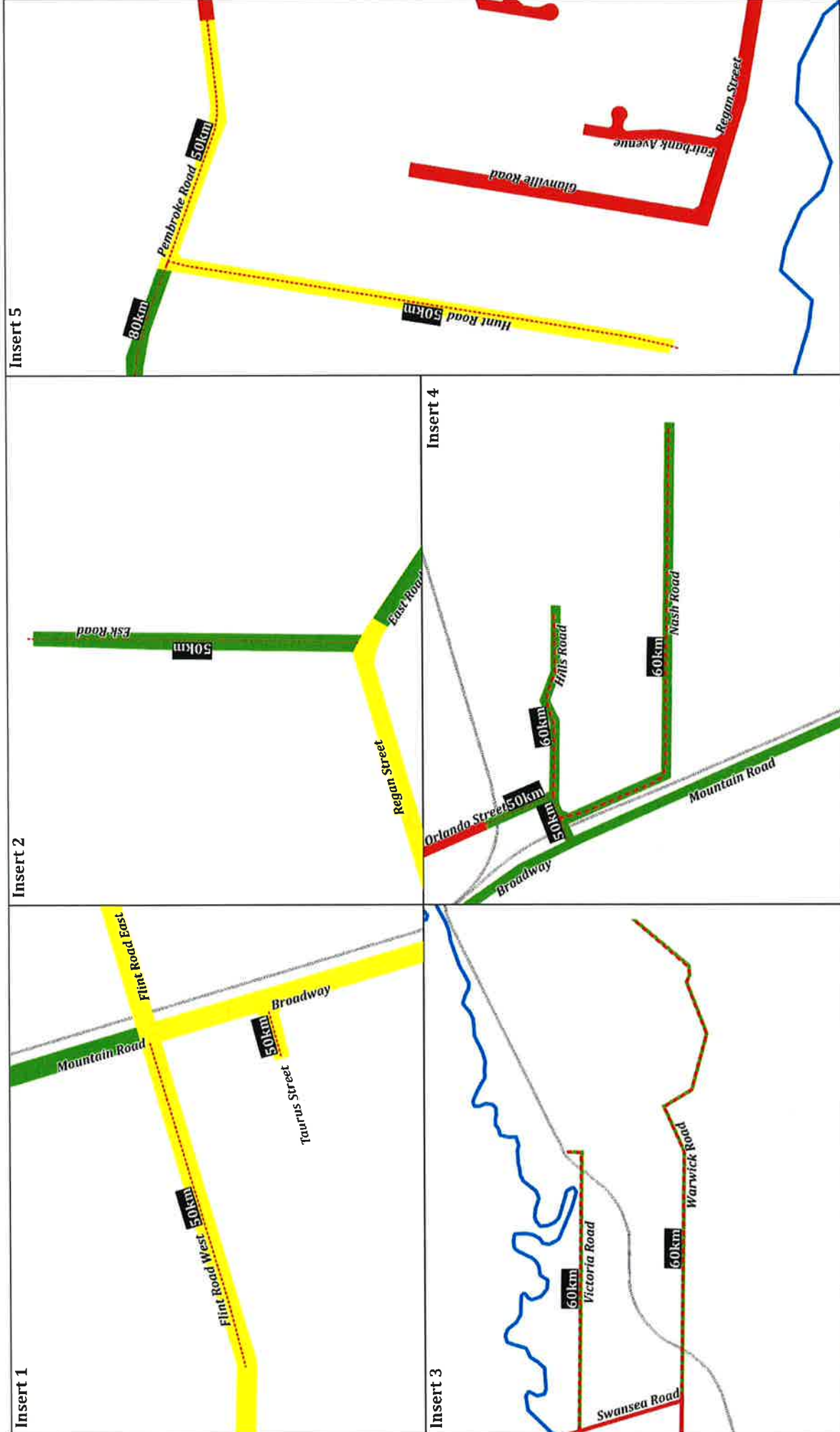

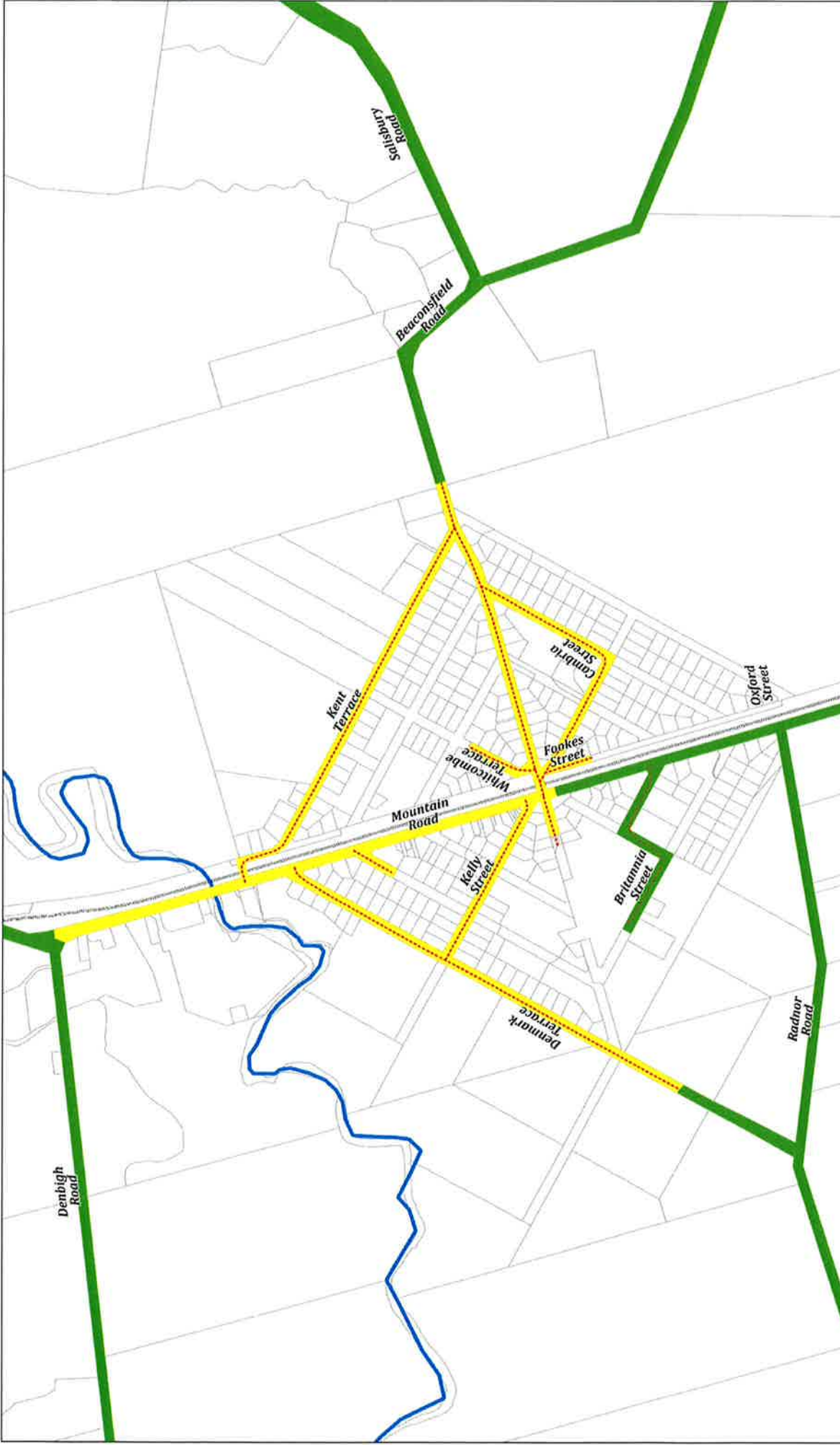



Map 6 - Whangamomona Roads Speed Limits


