The notice must be given in compliance with <u>regulation 36</u>, <u>37</u>, or <u>38</u> of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Regulations 2013 (whichever applies to this application).

Except in the case of a conveyance, within 10 working days after filing this application with the District Licensing Committee, the applicant must ensure that notice of this application in <u>form 7</u> is attached in a conspicuous place on or adjacent to the site to which this application relates (unless the Secretary of the District Licensing Committee agrees that it is impracticable or unreasonable to do so).
