Last chance to stand up for your district

With nominations for the local elections closing in **TWO DAYS**, Stratford District Council Chief Executive **Sven Hanne** is urging those interested in standing to get their nominations in **NOW**.

Mr Hanne said, "As of Monday this week we had 7 confirmed candidates running. Our community want to have a choice when it comes to voting, and for that to happen, we need people to step up."

"We need leaders to help shape the future of our district and I encourage people from all walks of life to consider running. You don't need a specific qualification, but you need to be passionate about this place, be able to listen to your community members and bring good ideas to the table," said Mr Hanne. "I know there are plenty of people that will fit that description in our community, this is your time, don't miss the opportunity to make your mark."

Those wanting to stand for Council must have a physical copy of their completed nomination form accepted by electoral officers before 12noon on Friday 12 August 2022.

"We encourage candidates to get their paperwork in before Friday as this gives our electoral officers time to ensure they have included everything necessary on their application to be in the running," said Mr Hanne. "We are not able to provide an extension, so don't leave it too late."

Are you ready to vote? You need to enrol.

Get ready to Make Your Mark and vote in the 2022 local elections. Make sure you're enrolled before Friday 12 August so you and your whānau receive your voting packs in the mail this September.

Check if you are enrolled

It's easy to see if you are enrolled to vote, simply scan the QR code to the right (or visit vote.nz). Type in some details and it'll let you know whether you're currently enrolled or not. If you're not enrolled, you can do this online as well. You'll need a form of ID with you for this.

Did you know?

Need a kick up the arts?

A Creative Communities Scheme (CCS) grant could help you get your project off the ground.

A funding application can be made by an individual or group, however funding is awarded to the whole project or activity, rather than the individual undertaking the project. To be eligible for funding the project must support at least one of the following criteria:

- **Access and participation** - create opportunities for local communities to engage with and participate in arts activities.
- **Diversity** - support the diverse arts and cultural traditions of local communities
- **Young people** - enable and encourage young people (under 18 years) to engage with and participate in the arts.
