Dog Registrations 2022/23

Stratford District Dog Control fees for the 12 month period from 1 July 2022 to 30 June 2023 are available to view online at stratford.govt.nz

The criteria for dog registration categories are defined within the Stratford District Council Dog Control Policy, also found online at stratford.govt.nz

Discounted fees apply if dog registrations are paid prior to 1 August 2022.

Infringements may be issued for all outstanding registrations after 1 October 2022. Fees are subject to the adoption of the Annual Plan 2022/23 by Council.

Did you know?

The most common plastic in Aotearoa is the single-use plastic bottle.

WasteMINZ research tells us we use 188 of these single-use plastic bottles per household every year. Despite being fully recyclable, 36 of the bottles (or nearly one in five) end up in landfill instead of being recycled.
