Dog Registration - Select Owner Status for 2022/23

Attention all urban dog owners who are currently either listed as Good or General Owners. If you think you qualify to become a select owner it is now time to apply.

To qualify as a Select Owner all of the following criteria must be met.

"Select Dog Owner" - Any person who meets:

- the good owner policy requirements; and
- dog neutering requirements; and
- fencing requirements; and
- all the dog bylaw requirements; and
- has made an application to be a Select Owner by 30 April 2022.

Application for Select Owner status must be received by 30 April 2022. An application form can be found online at stratford.govt.nz or from Council's Service Centre Monday to Friday 8.30am to 4.30pm.

Banana peels need help to decompose quickly in your compost bin.



Banana peels break down in your compost bin, but they'll decompose faster if you first chop them up into smaller pieces before adding them to the compost.

A whole banana peel sitting alone on the ground or buried in a landfill somewhere may take months, if not years, to break down, depending on conditions so don't throw them in your general rubbish.
