New pipe bridge installed for second water trunkmain

Stratford's second water trunkmain is weeks away from being completed, with the last pieces of infrastructure being fitted throughout September.

A key milestone in the project was recently completed, with the installation of a new pipe bridge across the Pātea River. This involved welding the old bridge to the new one then using rollers to pull the old bridge off the existing supporting structures and replace it with the new bridge.

As part of the second water trunkmain project there will be times in the coming month when contractors need to turn off the town's water supply to safely complete infrastructure connections. Residents will be told in advance of this work occurring.
