Stratford District Council will close Junction Road approximately 400m east of the Mangaoapa Road intersection to move the road away from an underslip.

Check your eligibility for a rates rebate!

If you're a residential ratepayer on a low income, you may be eligible for a maximum \$750 partial rebate on your rates.

The government sets the criteria and rebate amounts. If you meet the criteria, you can apply for a rebate on your rates bill for the year from 1 July 2023 to 30 June 2024. You must return your application to us by 30 June 2024.
