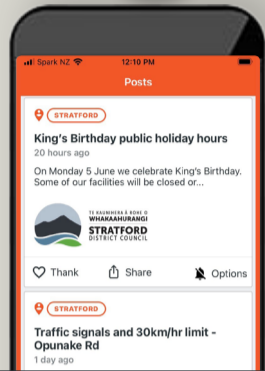

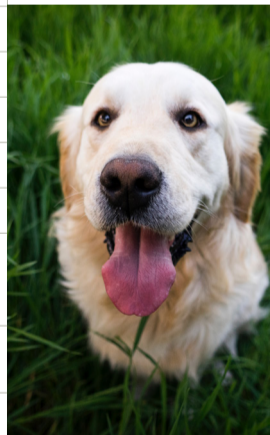

### Dog registration fees for a 12 month period from 1 July 2023 to June 2024

In accordance with Section 37 of the Dog Control Act 1996 the following will be the Dog Control fees for the 12 month period from 1 July 2023 to 30 June 2024.
