### Reduce your dog registration fees. Apply to become a 'Select' owner

Attention all urban dog owners who are currently listed as 'Good Owners'. If you qualify to become a 'Select Owner', now is the time to apply so you'll pay less for your future dog registration fees!

To become a 'Select Owner', you need to be able to tick these boxes:

Live in an urban zoned dog area.

- Be already classed as a 'Good Owner' or able to meet the 'Good Owner' requirements. You're likely to be in this category if you've not been convicted for dog offences, or if within the last two years you've not had a dog impounded on more than one occasion, and not received a written warning or infringement notice. If you're not sure what your classification is, you can call us on 06 765 6099.
- Have an adequately fenced area on your property.
- All your dogs are neutered or any un-neutered dogs are pedigrees registered with New Zealand Dogs.
- Submitted your completed application form **no later than 30 April 2024**. Late applications will not be accepted, even if you're just a little bit late.

### Water restrictions are still in force

Recent rain hasn't been enough to restore our river levels, and water restrictions are still on for properties using the Stratford, Toko, and Midhirst water supply.

SDC Services Asset Manager John Cooper says, "Our awa is still at a low flow, which means we're restricted with how much water we can take for our town supply. Please keep the effort up and follow the restrictions. Thanks to everyone who is doing their part to be water wise. Keep your great efforts going."

The restrictions including a total ban on the use of sprinklers, irrigation systems, and unattended hoses is currently in place and the following hand-held hose restrictions apply:

- Houses with even numbers can use a hand-held hose only on even numbered days; and
- Houses with odd numbers can use a hand-held hose only on odd numbered days.

If everyone makes small changes to their water consumption, it can add up to a big difference.
